#### **VIRGINIA SCHWEIZER (1922 - 2020)**

Virginia (Ginny) Schweizer, beloved member of our congregation, passed away on Thursday, June 4, 2020, at the age of 97 (she would have turned 98 on June 15). She was residing at the Chemung County Nursing Facility at the time of her passing. In 1967, Ginny married Paul A. Schweizer, who passed away in 2004. In addition to their love for each other, they shared a passion for aviation, particularly for soaring. Ginny was a very famous aviatrix, a pioneering female sailplane pilot and promoter of soaring and women in aviation. She set a number of records and received a number of awards for her achievements, including induction into the National Soaring Hall of Fame in 1971. Ginny was a really nice person – friendly, warm, upbeat, and unfailingly gracious. She will truly be missed.

#### PROPERTY COMMITTEE UPDATE

The Property Committee continues to be very busy.

Recent projects have included:

- Continued maintenance/mowing of church exterior grounds.
- Monthly inspections of our roof, basement, sump pumps, dehumidifier and exterior lighting.
- Repaired, stabilized, and repainted our church sign, which had fallen over during a high wind event.
- Monitored operation of our water softener. This led to replacement (by Chemung Softwater) and recalibration of the timer unit which, in turn, has resulted in much lower salt usage and more efficient performance.
- Continued monitoring of our utility and insurance costs.
- Refurbishment of our "Rene's Garden" on Church Street.
- Brush cleanup (thank you Wilsoncroft Family!!!) along north side of our Welles Land property.

Projects planned or under discussion include:

- Coordinating with our Pastor, Session, and Worship Committee to plan for safe resumption of worship services in our sanctuary.
- Establishing protocols for cleaning our facility and establishing policies and procedures for building use.
- Investigating the operation of our chime system.
- Power washing the north side of our building (and other areas as needed).
- Installing anti-skid strips on our outside ramp.
- Addressing a drainage problem along the east side of our parking lot.
- Assessment of the condition of our steeple.
- Development of a church Emergency Operation Plan.

A number of our projects will be costly but are extremely important. Any and all contributions to our Building Fund will be gratefully received. Thank you for your support!
